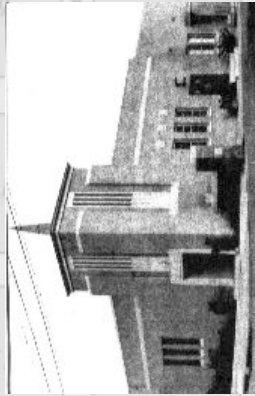
Our History
